The Animal Health Jobs Difference

www.AnimalHealthJobs.com (AHJ) is not just another employment website. Our primary purpose is to supply employers with prescreened, qualified candidates that meet the highest standards of the animal health and nutrition industries.

Our skilled recruiters screen each job seeker's resume and credentials prior to approving them to register with our site, thereby completing the first stage of the selection process by eliminating nonqualified individuals. You have three ways you can receive job applications:

Option 1 : Prescreened & Direct Email

Before being allowed to apply for a position, all job seekers are screened for industry experience. As a potential employer, you can designate on your account a contact email address for applications and receive the following from each candidate:

- **Summary of qualifications (profile)**
- **Resume and contact information**

Your job postings are stored under your AHJ account, and all applications for each job posting are captured under that posting for your review and later use, building a reservoir of qualified job seekers.

Option 2 : Prescreened & Website Link

To better integrate AnimalHealthJobs.com into your ongoing recruiting efforts, you may designate a permanent link to your website for receiving pre-screened applications. Under this option, job postings are stored under your AHJ account, but applications which flow directly to your website are not.

Option 3 : Open to All Job Seekers

Under this option, you include either an email address or a link to your website directly in the body of your job posting. This allows all interested parties who read your job posting to apply directly to you without signing into the AHJ system and thereby skipping the preliminary screening process. Job postings are stored under your AHJ account, but applications are not.

Search Engine Indexing

Job postings listed on AnimalHealthJobs.com are automatically indexed to two larger nationwide job search engines – Indeed.com and SimplyHired.com – greatly increasing job seeker visibility.

Extended Job Postings

Unlike other websites that post jobs for 30 days, AHJ posts jobs for 90 days, giving your job longer exposure. This is done because many jobs in the animal health industry require degrees and/or experience in specialized disciplines, so qualified candidates are harder to find. We also update our postings on connected job search

engines at 30 and 60 day intervals, bringing those jobs back to the top of the search list for extended visibility.
